The ending to this book is more of a cliff-hanger than the last one. Now, self-appointed leader Rosie finds herself not only trying to protect herself, but three other girls as they flee the school. Paddy is locked up below deck, having finally been caught as a stowaway.

This second installment in the Tomorrow Girls series is narrated from Rosie's point of view. One wants to believe it, but the bow is almost imperceptibly starting to dip into the freezing Atlantic Ocean - and our four main characters are thrown into a race for survival. Louisa, who can be okay sometimes; Maddie, who can't stop complaining; and Evelyn, the girl with a million conspiracy theories.
