The Thracians had been persuaded by Claudius Glaber to serve as auxiliaries in the Roman legions in a campaign against the Getae, who had often plundered Thracian lands. This accords with Florus' passage "He also celebrated the obsequies of his belief in the bravery of sacrifice."
